<p>Quarry Tour</p> <p>To gather an understanding of a quarry, the group visited the operational Pound Road quarry. Pound Road has been a primary Fulton Hogan quarry for many years, and is presently at the end of its life. The group firstly viewed the overall site and the operating processing plant from a high level remediated area, and then the processing plant for a close up view and explanation of the actual process.</p> <p>The group then visited the in development Roydon quarry, observing the constructed bunds en-route, entering the in progress pit floor excavation, viewing the water storage bladder area and then the roundabout area and environmental , monitoring station en-route back to Miners Road (via the new Dawsons Road roundabout link)</p>

General Discussions

The meeting primarily took place as the quarry tour, during which many informal discussions occurred. Significant topics were

- Dust and water monitors
- Technologies for access control including those presently being implemented on other sites
- Completion of roundabout by Christmas
- Extraction to Pound Road in new year
- New plant installation at end of 2023

Community Issues – Open Discussion

FH tabled incident summary. Community incident was discussed – observed trucks not associated with Roydon

Website access – there have been some issues with monitoring data accessibility, meeting viewed site, FH advised updated site on new platform is in development – old platform stretched but is accessible at www.fultonhoganquarries.com FH will advise this group once the new platform is live. Will then be included in public communications

Dust – photo of Friday 4th November was tabled (& subsequently forwarded) of dust visible behind the northern bund – FH has since investigated and responded directly

Consents – showing as not activated on ECan website – determined that this is the new consent (post-variation), original consent activation would usually automatically transfer to subsequent consent, has been rectified since

Public communications – Open Discussion

TRA newsletter will include a Roydon note next issue (February)

Trucks will start leaving the site taking material to Pound Road early next year – it will be important to have communications out about that before it starts

Impending Work – summary of general discussions & updates

December – road closure to allow final roundabout works

January – quarry access road in use

Viewing platform, perimeter walking tracks and Jones Road access upgrade in design
